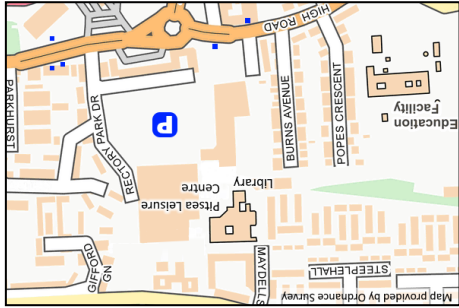
LIBRARY
